Database Curator for the EVOLTREE Network
at EFI Bordeaux Office, France**

EFI undertakes forest research and policy support at pan-European and global level, with headquarters located in Joensuu, Finland. EFI has its other main offices in Barcelona, Bonn, Bordeaux and Brussels. The Institute has app. 100 staff members and has an annual turnover of app. 14 million Euros. We are looking to recruit a Database Curator for feeding, curating, organizing genomic and genetic data of the Evoltree eLab. We require a resourceful individual to contribute to the extension of the GD2 database (Georeferenced Database of Genetic Diversity).

Key responsibilities will include:

- Extraction of genetic data from the scientific literature reporting genetic surveys of natural tree populations.
- Interaction with the contact authors of the articles to complete the data sets.
- Annotation of the data and uploading on the GD2 database.
- Work with the eLab database manager to improve the GD2 content and services.

Qualifications

- A university degree (BSc or MSc) in life sciences and a broad knowledge of biological and genetic diversity.
- Previous experience in using Windows (Excel, Word) and biological databases is required.
- Previous database curation and/or editorial experience is advantageous, but not essential.
- The post-holder will work closely with other members of the Evoltree eLab (Antoine Kremer, François Ehrenmann)

Duty Station

The person will be based at EFI Bordeaux Office, which is located at INRA Bordeaux Centre in Cestas, France.

Employment Conditions

The employee will be an EFI staff member. The total duration of employment will be up to 6 months, with no possibility of extension. The successful candidate is expected to take up the position as soon as possible.
